

2011 Cutaneous Lymphoma Foundation Young Investigator Travel Award

The Cutaneous Lymphoma Foundation is soliciting nominations for the **2011 Young Investigator Travel Award** which will support travel to the Society for Investigative Dermatology (SID) Annual Meeting, May 4-7, 2011 in Phoenix, Arizona.

The CLF Young Investigator Travel Award is for \$1,500 to support the travel of a young investigator who will be attending the 2011 SID meeting and presenting CTCL related research.

Criteria for selection of the Young Investigator Award include:

- Individuals with a M.D. or Ph.D. degree.
- Individuals with an academic rank no greater than assistant professor.
- Individuals with demonstrable interest and/or achievement in clinical care, education or research in CTCL.
- Individuals who have submitted an abstract and will presenting research at the 2011 SID meeting.

The recipient of the CLF Young Investigator Award has traditionally presented their abstract in the CTCL Symposium, which will take place Thursday, May 5, 2011, 2:00pm-5:30pm.

The deadline for applications is February 14, 2011.

Final approval of the awardee will be made by the CLF Board of Directors and the awardee will be notified by April 4, 2011.
